Member Profile

Member is a 24 year old developmentally disabled ambulatory female who currently resides at Winnebago Mental Health Institute. She is independent with completing bathing, toileting, dressing, eating and mobility tasks. She is very proud of her appearance and works hard to maintain herself. She enjoys make up, clothes, going out to eat, getting her hair done, and "girly movies". She enjoys most types of music as well. When she is doing well, she is talkative, pleasant, and enjoys activities like arts and crafts.

Member is currently seeking a 1 bed Adult Family Home or Supported Apartment setting anywhere in Wisconsin.

- Member requires assistance with meal preparation, medication management, money management and transportation. She is able to prepare very simple meals, but needs to be supervised in the kitchen for safety. Her long term goal is to live in her own apartment, she reports that she is willing to learn to complete the above tasks. She is able to complete laundry and other chore tasks independently, but will need prompts and guidance to complete the tasks appropriately.
- Member is independent with completing bathing, toileting, dressing, eating and mobility tasks. She is very proud of her appearance and works hard to maintain herself. If having behaviors, she will remain supervised to maintain safety.
- Member has a history of making inappropriate decisions for herself. She is at risk for elopement, SIB and threats of suicide, verbal and physical aggression and other inappropriate behaviors. She does require 24 hour supervision and 2:1 coverage to ensure her and staff's safety. She has a history of making false accusations about staff treatment.

Environmental Modifications/Requirements

- Home must have all areas with enclosed and protected electronics and windows with Lexan.
- Home must have limited access to neighbors with translucent windows to limit member ability to visually engage the public in viewing her inappropriate dress or behavior.
- Home must have washable surfaces throughout with no cloth or carpet.
- Home must have all furniture secured.
- Home must have personalized programming for member activities as member is not a candidate for day programming.
- Secured drawers, doors, appliances, and any sharp items.

Member Challenges

- Verbal and physical aggression toward that can escalate to attempted staff injury.
- Allegations of staff abuse.
- Triangulating staff and team members.
- Threats of self harm and superficial self harm.
- Threats of suicide.
- Swallowing objects and liquids.
- Smearing feces and urine.
- Damage to property and vehicles.

Diagnoses

Anxiety Disorder, PTSD, Sexual Abuse (perp and victim), Traits consistent with Borderline Personality Disorder, Borderline MR, Obesity, Psychosocial Stressors, Conduct Disorder, Bipolar.

Additional needs

- Restrictive measures application has been in place to include supportive guides.
- Exceptional measures for appointments to include wrist and ankle restraints and wheelchair use for professional's safety.
